

Provided further that the appropriation for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION 21. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by

law.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-1959 VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE CONTRACTING FOR THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH IN THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO:

Section 1. That is it hereby determined to proceed with the granting of an exclusive franchise to an independent contractor for the collection of all residential and commercial garbageand residential and commercial rubbish generated within the Village of Centerville, Ohio.

Section 2. That the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Centerville, Ohio be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids to collect residential and commercial garbage and residential and commercial rubbish on the terms and conditions which have this day been presented to this Council.

Section 3. The foregoing ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately upon its passage, the said emergency which is found and declared to exist being the immediate need for proper and efficient regulation and collection of garbage and rubbish within the Village to insure the public health and welfare.
