Section 2. The Village Engineer is hereby directed forthwith to amend the Zoning Map of Centerville, Ohio, in pursuance of this classification for zoning purposes and in conformity with the foregoing resolution, and such classification for zoning shall be immediately applicable to the annexed territory until amended by further proceedings in the manner provided by the Zoning Ordinance of Centerville.

RESOLUTION NO. 5--1957

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
CENTERVILLE, OHIO

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING PUBLIC DEPOSITORY AND AWARDING
PUBLIC MONEYS PURSUANT TO THE UNIFORM DEPOSITORY ACT
OF OHIO, BY THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Centerville finds that the notice for application for deposit of Village moneys was duly published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the probable amount of active deposits to be deposited during the period of designation shall be twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) and the probable maximum amount to be so deposited at any time during such period shall be Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00); and

WHEREAS, a written application has been received from the Winters National Bank & Trust Company of Dayton, Ohio, for the receipt of active deposits in the amount of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) from the Village of Centerville, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that the sureties and securities tendered are proper, to-wit, U. S. Government securities or other collateral in accordance with the Uniform Depository Act of Ohio in the amount of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, as follows:

That the deposit of the moneys of the Village of Centerville, Ohio, be awarded in the case of active deposits to the Winters National Bank & Trust Company of Dayton, Ohio, which bank shall become the depository for the moneys of the Village for a period of two (2) years upon duly executing and delivering a written memorandum or agreement for deposits of public funds in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 135.13, 135.14, 135.15 and 135.16.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 5, 1957

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE AND ERECTION
OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC "STOP" SIGNS WITHIN THE SAID VILLAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That traffic "stop" signs of the type and design approved by the Director of Highways, State of Ohio, shall be erected for the purpose of regulating vehicular traffic at the following street intersections and junctions of streets, such erection to be made under the direction of the Village Marshal:

1. Maple, Linden, Cherry and Elmwood Streets north and south onto Bradstreet Road.
2. Hampton Road east and west onto West Ridgeway Road.
3. Lyons Drive north at the intersection with Davis Road.
4. East Ridgeway Road west onto Maple Street
5. An existing unnamed north-south alley lying between Main Street and East Drive, for southbound traffic at Weller Avenue.

SECTION 2. That the expenditure of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the purchase of said "stop" signs is authorized and the expenditure of additional sums necessary in the determination of the Village Marshal to erect such signs at the designated intersections and in-junctions.

SECTION 3. That failure to heed such signs shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall subject the operators of vehicles so failing to a fine not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)

SECTION 4. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect within the period prescribed by law.
