ORDINANCE NUMBER 5, 1957

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE AND ERECTION OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC "STOP" SIGNS WITHIN THE SAID VILLAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That traffic "stop" signs of the type and design approved by the Director of Highways, State of Ohio, shall be erected for the purpose of regulating vehicular traffic at the following street intersections and junctions of streets, such erection to be made under the direction of the Village Marshal:

- 1. Maple, Linden, Cherry and Elmwood Streets north and south onto Bradstreet Road.
- Hampton Road east and west onto West Ridgeway Road.
 Lyons Drive north at the intersection with Davis Road.
- 4. East Ridgeway Road west onto Maple Street
 5. An existing unnamed north-south alley lying between
 Main Street and East Drive, for southbound traffic
 at Weller Avenue.

SECTION 2. That the expenditure of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the purchase of said "stop" signs is authorized and the expenditure of additional sums necessary in the determination of the Village Marshal to erect such signs at the designated intersections and injunctions.

SECTION 3. That failure to heed such signs shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall subject the operators of vehicles so failing to a fine not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)

SECTION 4. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect within the period prescribed by law.
