ORDINANCE NO. 12-1953

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE

To fix the salary of the Village Marshal

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

Section I. That the salary of the Village Marshal shall be Three Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$3,800.00) per annum, payable monthly.

Section II. That the duly appointed Village Marshal shall furnish a fidelity bond for the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) given by a corporate surety acceptable to the Village Council.
