

ORDINANCE NO. 3 - 1952

Village of CENTERVILLE

To fix the salary of the Village Marshal.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

Section I. That the salary of the Village Marshall shall be Three Thousand Forty Dollars (\$3,040.00) per annum payable monthly.

Section II. That the duly appointed Village Marshal shall furnish a fidelity bond for the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) given by a corporate surety acceptable to the Council.

Section III. That all Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be repealed and this Ordinance take effect from and after the first (1st) day of January, 1952.

ORDINANCE No. 3-A - 1952

Village of CENTERVILLE

To fix the salary of the Deputy Marshal of said Village.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

Section I. That the Salary of the Village Deputy Marshal shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) per annum.

Section II. That the duly appointed Village Deputy Marshal shall furnish a fidelity bond for the faithful performance of duty in the sum of \$1,000.00 to be made by a corporate surety acceptable to the Village Mayor.

Section III. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the 1st day of January 1952.
