ORDINANCE NUMBER 5 - 1952

Village of CENTERVILLE

To fix the rate of compensation for casual common labor employed by said Village.

Section I. That the rate of compensation to be paid for casually employed common laborers by the said Village shall be ONE DOLLAR and TWENTY-FIVE (\$1.25) per hour worked.

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ORDINANCE NUMBER 6 - 1952

Village of CENTERVILLE

To regulate and establish standard specifications for the construction of streets and roadways within the said village.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

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Section I. That the following standard specifications for New Streets and Roadways for Centerville as approved by the Village Planning Board shall be adopted to control the construction of streets and roadways within said Village, and the construction of any street or roadway by any person in such a manner not in conformity with said specifictions hereinafter contained, be and the same is hereby prohibited.

> That said standard specifications hereby adopted are as follows: Section II.

STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR NEW STREETS AND ROADWAYS FOR CENTERVILLE, OHIO

For the convenience of interested parties and to eliminate confusion these specifications are separated into three basic categories:

- Preparation of Sub-Base l.
- Construction of Base Course 2.
- Construction of Bituminous Pavement 3.

PREPARATION OF SUB-BASE:

The first operation shall be the removal of all foreign matter from the street area such as grass, shrubs, trees, or other undesirable material. If bog areas of spring areas are in evidence the immediate area shall be excavated to a satisfactory depth (approximately 24 inches), a French Type drain installed or tiles installed and the excavation refilled with coarse washed grave. The French Drain or tiles should be so installed that the water will be carried away a satisfactory distance from the immediate street site.
