

ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 1949

It is hereby provided that, beginning with the 1st day of April, 1949, the rates charged for water furnished by the Village of Centerville to the residents of the Village of Centerville shall be as follows:

Five Dollars (\$5.00) for the first 7,500 gallons or any part thereof used per quarter

Thirty-Five Cents (\$.35) for each additional thousand gallons used during said quarter.

The rates for users outside the corporate limits of the Village of Centerville shall be the same as those charged residents in the Village of Centerville, except that an additional charge of Twenty-Five per cent (25%) of the rates prevailing under this Ordinance in said Village shall be added, to be paid by users outside the corporate limits of said Village of Centerville.

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
(Village)

An Ordinance to make Appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1950.

Section 1. Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, That, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Centerville during the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1950, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

Section 20. And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriation for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 21. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
