#### ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 1949

It is hereby provided that, beginning with the 1st day of April, 1949, the rates charged for water furnished by the Village of Centerville to the residents of the Village of Centerville shall be as follows:

Five Dollars (\$5.00) for the first 7,500 gallons or any part thereof used per quarter

Thirty-Five Cents (\$.35) for each additional thousand gallons used during said quarter.

The rates for users outside the corporate limits of the Village of Centerville shall be the same as those charged residents in the Village of Centerville, except that an additional charge of Twenty-Five per cent (25%) of the rates prevailing under this Ordinance in said Village shall be added, to be paid by users outside the corporate limits of said Village of Centerville.

Provided further that the appropriation for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.
