ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 1945

TO ESTABLISH THE GRADE OF LINWOOD AVENUE FROM MAPLE AVENUE EAST TO THE EAST PROPERTY LINE OF WEIDNER PLAT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, STATE OF CHIO,

That the Grade of Linwood Avenue from Maple Avenue east to the east Section 1. property line of Weidner plat shall be, and the same is hereby established as follows:

Beginning at the west property line of Weidner Plat and the center line of said Linwood Avenue, elevation 1022.0; thence descending at the rate of .80 of a foot per 100 feet for a distance of 200 feet; thence descending at the rate of 1.0 per 100 feet for a distance of 400 feet; thence descending at the rate of 1.6 feet per 100 feet for a distance of 470 feet to the east property line of said Weidner Plat.
