

ORDINANCE NO. 6 - 1943

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY AND STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1943.

Section 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Village of Centerville during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1943, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 11. And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officer authorized by law to approve same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 12. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
