ORDINANCE NO.1 1942

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY AND STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1942

Section 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, That, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Centerville during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1942, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated, as follows:

Section 2. That there be appropriated from the GENERAL FUND:

A. GENERAL FUND

Table with 3 columns: Item Number, Description, Amount. Includes Council, Mayor, Clerk, Treasurer, Solicitor, Building Inspector, Legal Advertising, Supplies and Miscellaneour, Board of Health, Elections, Contingencies.

Total General Fund - - - - - \$1,119.78

Section 3. That there be appropriated from the GENERAL FUND of CONTINGENCIES for purposes not otherwise provided for, to be expended in accordance with the provisions of Section 5625-32 General Code, the sum of -- - - - \$ 100.00

Section 4. That there be transferred from the GENERAL FUND to the SAFETY FUND the sum of \$2,585.00; and that there be appropriated from said SAFETY FUND the following:

B SAFETY FUND.

Table with 3 columns: Item Number, Description, Amount. Includes Marshal, Police, Station Houses, Other Police Expenses, Fire Chief - salary, Firement, Fire Apparatus, Fire Stations, Other Fire Dept. Expenses, Fire Hydrant Rentals.

Section 5. That there be transferred from the GENERAL FUND TO the SERVICE FUND the sum of \$513.00; and that there be appropriated from said SERVICE FUND the following:

C SERVICE FUND

Section 6. That there be appropriated from the WATER FUND:

Section 8. That there be appropriated from the GASOLINE TAX STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR FUND the following:

Section 11. And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of two-thirds vote of council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 12. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
