AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE OF PAY FOR COMMON LABOR EMPLOYED BY THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE AND ALL DEPARTMENTS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Chio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. The rate of pay for all Common Labor Employed by the Village of Centerville and alldepartments thereof, is hereby fixed at the sum of fifty centd (50%), per hour,

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for common Labor to be employed by the Village of Center - ville or any department therof, at an hourly rate less than that above provided.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be inforce from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
