

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE OF PAY FOR COMMON LABOR EMPLOYED BY THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE AND ALL DEPARTMENTS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. The rate of pay for all Common Labor Employed by the Village of Centerville and all departments thereof, is hereby fixed at the sum of fifty centd (50¢), per hour,

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for Common Labor to be employed by the Village of Centerville or any department thereof, at an hourly rate less than that above provided.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31st, 1941

Section 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF Centerville, State of Ohio, That, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Centerville during the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1941, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

Section 11. And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be paid or drawn for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance, Provided further that the appropriation for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made,

Section 12. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
