and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles heretofore apporved and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefoom, if any, sahll be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement shall be a ssessed by the foot front upon the following described losts and lands, to-wit: all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said losts and lands are hereby determined to be specifically benefited by said improvement; and the cost of said improvement sahll include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys, and of printing and publishing the notices, resolutions and ordinance required, and the serving of said notices, and cost of construction, together with interest on notes and bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in one annual installment, with interest on such payment, at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof; provided that the owner of any property assessed, may, at his option, pay such assessment in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessing ordinance.

Section 5. That bonds of the Village of Centerville shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto; and, notes of said village village shall be issued in anticipation of the levying of such assessment and the issue of such bonds.

Section 6. That the Village Engineer be and he is hereby directed to prepare and filewwith this council a tentative assessment showing the amount to be assessed on each lot or parcel of land to be assessed.

Section 7. That the Village Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and idrected to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
