Sec. 14: Each Section of this Ordinance, and each sub-division of any Section thereof is hereby declared to be independent, and the finding or holding of any Section or subdivision of any Section thereof to be invalor void shall not be deemed or held to effect the validity of any other Section or subdivision of this Ordinance.

Sec. 15: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 14 - 1939

ACCEPTING APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected thereto concurring;

Sec. 1. That the application of said Village of Centerville for the annexation of the following described continguous territory:

"Situate in the Township of Washington, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Town 2, Range 6, MRs. and described as follows:
