

An Ordinance to protect Quarry Lake, the source of the Village Water Supply from pollution and to declare an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained, by the Council of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected thereto concurring:

Sec. 1. It is unlawful to bathe or swim in or to operate a motor boat upon Quarry Lake, which is the source of the village water supply.

Sec. 2. Whoever violates this ordinance in any of the foregoing particulars shall be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

Sec. 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public peace, health and safety of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio require the immediate protection of Quarry Lake, the source of the village water supply from pollution, and it shall take effect upon its passage.

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE YEAR 1939

An Ordinance to make supplemental appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1939.

Sec. 1.
