Sec. 9. Upon The Dayton Power and Light Company filing its written acceptance of this ordinance with the Clerk of said Village, within thirty-(30) days from the taking effect hereof, this ordinance shall be and constitute a contract between said Village and Company to light the streets, lanes, alleys, avenues and public grounds, in accordance herewith, for sixty (60) days from the 29th day of October, 1939.

Sec. 10. That his ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

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ORDINANCE NO. 28 - 1939

To fix the salaries and bonds of certain officers.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery, and State of Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected thereto concurring:

Sec. 1. That the salary of the mayor shall be the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per annum, payable quarterly, and he shall give bond in the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

Sec. 2. That the salary of the village clerk shall be the sum of One hundred, thirty (\$130.00) Dollars per annum, payable quarterly, and she shall give bond in the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

Sec. 4. That the salary of the marshal shall be the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per annum, payable quarterly, and he shall give bond in the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars.

Sec. 3. That the salary of the village treasurer shall be the sum of One hundred, thirty (\$130.00) Dollars per annum, payable quarterly, and she shall give bond in the sum of Four thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars.

Sec. 5. That the salary of each member of the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs shall be the sum of Twenty-four (\$24.00) Dollars per annum, payable quarterly, and each shall give bond in the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars.

Sec. 6. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be repealed and this ordinance take effect from and after January 1, 1940.
