

## RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 57

An Ordinance regulating traffic at the intersection of main and Franklin Streets. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF CENT-  
ERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

(in said Village)

Section 1. That whenever the traffic control apparatus/exhibits a "green" light or "go" signal vehicles facing the signal may proceed straight through the intersection, but in proceeding across the intersection or entering into the intersection for the purpose of turning, shall yield the right-of-way to other vehicles or pedestrians lawfully in the intersection at the time the light changes. Vehicles may turn either to the right or to the left.

Section 2. When the color "Red" is exhibited by said traffic control apparatus, or the word "stop" shows, vehicles and pedestrians facing the signal shall stop, and shall remain stationary until "Green" or "Go" alone shows.

Section 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than one dollar (1.00) and no more than ten dollars (10.00) and shall pay the costs of the prosecution.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by reason of the fact that it is necessary to immediately regulate Traffic in said Village and for this reason this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
