## RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 38

TO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

A traffic guide post be established and maintained at the main crossing of the streets of said village known as the Dayton and Lebanon Pike and the Mismisburg and Bellbrook pike in said Village. All persons are required by this ordinance to pass on the right of said guide post, there shall be no left hand turns until after said guide post shall have been passed on the right. Any person or persons tampering or medling with said guid post shall upon conviction or anyone who fails to obey or who Violates this ordinance upon conviction shall be fined any sum from two dollars to twenty five dollars. If said fine and costs are not paid may be confined in the County Jail until said costs and fine are paid, or caused to be paid at the descretion of the Mayor.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earlest period allowed by waw.
