

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 38

TO _____

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
 OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

A traffic guide post be established and maintained at the main crossing of the streets of said village known as the Dayton and Lebanon Pike and the Miamisburg and Bellbrook pike in said Village. All persons are required by this ordinance to pass on the right of said guide post, there shall be no left hand turns until after said guide post shall have been passed on the right. Any person or persons tampering or meddling with said guide post shall upon conviction or anyone who fails to obey or who Violates this ordinance upon conviction shall be fined any sum from two dollars to twenty five dollars. If said fine and costs are not paid may be confined in the County Jail until said costs and fine are paid, or caused to be paid at the discretion of the Mayor.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by Law.
