Ordinance No. 40 See Page 48TO Regulate and control the speed of Motor VehiclesBE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

An ordinance to regulate and control the speed of Motor Vehicles within the limits of the Village of Centerville Ohio---

sec(1) That it shall be unlawful for any person to operate any kind of motor vehicle within the Corporation limits of the village of Centerville at a greater speed then fifteen miles an hour or that indangers the property life or limb of any person shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Twenty five Dollars and for a second affence in any sum not to exceed fifty Dollars.

If said fine and costs are not paid the guilty parties may be committed to the County Jail until said costs and fine are paid or caused to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect in fifteen days after passage.
