

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 41

TO Transfer Money's from one fund to another.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

In the commonpleas courts of Montgomery Co. Ohio.  
In the motto of the application ;  
of the council of the village of ;  
Centerville, Washington Township, ; Petition  
Montgomery County Ohio to Transfer Money ;  
from one fund to another. ;

Petitions, the Village of Centerville Washington Township  
Montgomery County, Ohio, represents that at a meeting held on  
the twenty first day of July, 1924, the council of said Village  
by a vote of more than  $\frac{5}{8}$  of the members thereof and the approval  
of the Mayor, Pased the following ordinance to wit

Whereas there is now in the treasury of the village of  
Centerville the sum of (157.02 Dollars) which is not required for  
the purpose for which it was appropriated, and whereas the General  
Fund and Safety fund of said village are at the present time  
depleted and wheras the object for which money was appropriated  
to the Health fund has been accomplished and is no longer nec  
cessary. Now therefore be it resolved and ordained by the council  
of the village of Centerville more then  $\frac{5}{8}$  of the members elected  
here to concurring that it is necessary that the sum of (\$100.00)  
be transfered from said health fund to said Safety fund and that  
the sum of (\$50.00) be transfered from the Health fund to the  
Gen. fund and that the village proceed to file apetition in the  
court of commonpleas of Montgomery County Ohio prajng that and  
order be issued authorizing said respective amounts from the Health  
fund to the Safty Fund and General fund.

That---Wherefore petitions prays that the court may order  
and direct that they be authorized to transfer said fund as in  
said ordinance set forth.
