

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 43TO Prevent advertising matter's on pole's or trees.BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THATBe it ordained by the village council of the Village of
Centerville, County of Montgomery and State of Ohio---

That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or Corporation, to past or attach any advertising matter whatsoever, either political, commercial or otherwise to any telephone pole, electric light pole or tree within the limits of the Village of Centerville.

That any person on conviction of violation of the ordinance shall be fined in any sum not to exceed twenty five dollars and cost of prosecution.

That if said fine and costs are not paid to be confined in the Jail of the County until they are paid or caused to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.

That this Ordinance shall be in force and effect in thirty days after its passage.
