## RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 44

TO Prevent Explosives of any kind.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Centerville County of Montgomery and State of Ohio;-

- Sec(1) That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to light and explode any kind of fire cracker, large or small, toy pistols or other explosives of any kind whatsoever on any day or night within the limits of the village of Centerville;
- Sec(2) That a violation of this ordinance upon conviction shall be deemed a misdemeanor and a nuisance and any person or persons convicted shall pay a fine in any sum not to exceed Twenty dollars and costs;
- Sec(3) That if said fines and costs are not paid said person or per sons are to be confined in County vail until said fine and costs ere paid or caused to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law:
- This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the Sec(4) carliest period allowed by Law.
