

AMENDMENT OF ORDANANCE NUMBER 45 A

Be it ordained by the council of the incorporated Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, State of Ohio, that ordinance, Number 45, of the Village of Centerville, Ohio, shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1 A traffic light has been established and maintained at intersection of Main and Franklin Streets of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio.

Sec. 2 All traffic are required by this ordinance to come to a full stop at this intersection, when light shows red.

Sec. 3 All traffic are required by this ordinance to move in the proper direction when light shows green.

Sec. 4 Any person or persons operating any kind of vehicle violates this ordinance upon conviction shall be fined any sum from \$2.00 to \$25.00. If said fines and costs are not paid may be confined in the County Jail until said costs and fines are paid or caused to be paid at the discretion of the Mayor.

This ordinance shall be enforced and in effect in thirty days after it's passage.
