

## RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 46TO Governing Liquor or Intoxication.BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Centerville County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, that whoever is found in a state of intoxication or whoever being intoxicated shall be fined in any sum not to exceed one hundred dollars and cost of prosecution under section 13194, General Code of Ohio.

Whoever is found guilty of the possession of liquor contrary to section 6212-16 General Code of Ohio, shall be fined not less than fifty dollars not more than two hundred dollars under section 6212-17, General Code of Ohio.

That whoever is found guilty of transporting liquor contrary to section 13216 General Code of Ohio shall be fined not less than fifty dollars not more than two hundred dollars under section 13216 General Code of Ohio.

That whoever is found guilty of operating a motor vehicle while in an intoxicated condition shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and may be imprisoned in the County Jail for not more than six months or both under section 12628-1 G.C.O.

That whoever buys intoxicating liquor for or sells or furnishes it to a person who is intoxicated or in the habit of getting intoxicated unless prescribed by a Physician shall be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and may be imprisoned not less than ten days nor more than thirty days or both.
