## RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 34

TO Prevent the unnecessary noise of Motor Driven Vehicles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE
OF Centerville Montgomery County OH10, THAT

- sec(1) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons operating a motor vehicle using gasoline or other explosive mixture as a motive power, shall use a multer which shall be sufficient to deaden the sound of the explosions, and such muffler shall not be disconnected or cut out while such motor vehicle is being operated upon any street, avenue, or alley within the Village of Centerville.
- sec(2) Any person or persons who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon a first conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than one dollar or more than ten dollars and upon a second conviction shall be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than twenty five dollars and upon a third conviction shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars nor more than fifty dollars and cost of prosecution.
- sec(3) That this ordinance number 34 shall take effect and be enforced from and after fifteen days from posted, Aug. 27, 1915.
