Ordinance No. 3

TO Prohibit Public Boxing exhibitions

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

It is unlawful for any two persons who argue, and willfully fight, fight or box at fist cuffs, or engage in any public spurring, or boxing exhibition without gloves, or with gloves of any kind within the limits of said village. And whoever aids, asserts, or attends any such boxing exhibition, or glove fight, and any miner, or before of any grounds, or lots building, hall or structure of any kind, permitting the same to be used for any such exhibition, or purpose, shall be deemed guilty of an affray. And upon conviction be fined in any sum not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars and costs of prosecution, and be imprisoned in the County Jail until said fine and costs are paid or secured to be paid otherwise discharged according to Law, Provided the forgoing shall not apply to any public Gymnasium, or Athletic Club, or any of the exercises thereon, if written permission for the specific purpose shall first obtained from the Mayor of said Village.
