

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

(Revised) Ordinance No. 7

TO Prevent Barbering on Sunday

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons to engage in the business of Barbering on the first day of the week commonly called Sunday.

sec(2) Whoever shall engage in the business of Barbering on the first day of the week commonly called Sunday within the limits of the incorporated Village of Centerville Ohio, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than fifteen dollars for first offence, and costs, and for a subsequent conviction for a like offence, not less than twenty dollars, nor more than Thirty dollars and costs of prosecution and be confined in the County Jail or Village Prison, or Village Workhouse until said fine and costs are paid or secured to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.
