

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 570 Amendment of Ordinance #9  
TO Nuisance of any kind

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

Ordinance #9 of the Village of Centerville Ohio shall be amended to read as follows.

Be it Ordained by the council of the Incorporated Village of Centerville Ohio that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons within the limit of said village to suffer any Privy, Stables, Hogpen, or any other building or place on his or her premises to become offensive to any other inhabitant of said village.

Any person or persons violating section one of this ordinance shall upon complaint of any person abate such Nuisance within five days from date of complaint.

Any person or persons neglecting to abate said nuisance within five days from date of complaint shall upon conviction be fined not more than ten dollars and costs and be confined in prison until fine and costs are paid or secured to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.

Any person or persons disturbing the good order peace and quiet of the corporation by clamer or noise in the street and other public places to the annoyance of citizens or otherwise violating the public peace by indecent or disorderly conduct in behavior shall upon conviction be fined in any sum from one dollar to twenty five dollars and cost. If said fine and costs are not paid to be confined in County Jail until paid or caused to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.

That the original ordinance #9 be and the same is hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect at the earliest date allowed.
