RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. Amendment of ordinance #10

TO Govern Peace

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

TO amend ordinance no. ten to read as follow's;  
Be it ordained by the village council of the incorporated Village of Centerville Montgomery Co. Ohio that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to disturb the peace and good order of any Religious assembly or any other public gathering within the limits of said village by any unnecessary noise or actions or disorderly behavior.

Any person or persons violating sec one of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any sum not exceeding thirty dollars and costs and be imprisoned until said fine and costs are paid or otherwise discharged according to law.

Any person or persons disturbing the peace and quiet of the village in any manner or from upon conviction be fined as above.

That the original ordinance #10 be and the same is hereby repealed.

This ordinance to be in force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
