Ordinance No. 11

TO Prevent Pasting Bills on Buildings

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(6883) Whoever paint, prints, pastes stencile, or otherwise marks upon RS or in any manorrplaces upon, or affixes to any building, fence, wall, or tree within the limits of said Village without the consent of the owner thereof any word, letter, character figure, sentence or device, or any hand bill or notice, shall upon convection be fined not more than Fifty dollars, nor less than five dollars, and costs of prosecution, and be imprisoned until said fine, and costs are paid, or secured to be,or otherwise discharged according to waw. But this section does apply to the posting of any handbills, or notice of any public sale of property by any Sheriff administrator, Executor or licensed Auctioneer or any notice required by waw to be posted.
