

## RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

(Revised)

Ordinance No. 12TO Prevent against obstructing Public HighwayBE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) It shall be unlawful for any band of Gypsies Travelers, Wanderers, or other person, or persons to camp in tent wagon, or otherwise on the public highway or lands adjacent thereto within the limits of said village for a longer period than twenty four hours without the consent of the owners of such adjacent land, or the consent the owners of land abutting on highway where such camping place is made.

sec(2) Any person, or persons violating the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding ten dollars, and costs of prosecution, and be imprisoned until said fine and costs are paid, or secured to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.
