

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 13

TO Regulate the speed of Moter Vehicle

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) That no person shall operate a moter vâchicle on the streets or highways of a rate of speed greater than is reasonable or proper, having regard to the width and the use of the highway, or street and the general cause usual, Rules of such street, or Road, so as not to endanger the property or limb of any person, of the safety of any property.

sec(2) In no event shall any Automobile Moter Vehicle Moter Cicle be operated at a greater rate of speed than eight miles an hour in the business or closely built up portions of said Village.

sec(3) The closely built up portion of the said Village of Centerville shall be as follows, on north main street beginning at the Public Watering Trough, thence south on said main street to, and including the Kindle lands, and Residence. An the East beginning with the residence of Mrs. Elliott, and extending West to and including the residence of D. B. Stancel.

sec(4) Any operator of a Moter Vicicle upon meeting a horsedrawn Vehicle, or overtaking one or person on horseback shall slow down, and stop said Moter Vehicle when signaled so to do, and shall remain in such condition until such horsedrawn Vehicle or other such other person on horseback shall have safely passed, provided however, that signal to stop be given in good faith, and under the necessity of the circumstances, and only so often and for such length of time as shall permit such Vehicle to safely pass, whether approaching from the front or from the rear, and in case of accident to a person, or property on the public highway of said Village due to the operator thereon of a Moter Vehicle. The person operating such Vehicle shall stop, and upon request of a person injured, or any person present give such person his name, and adress, and if not the owner, the name, and adress of such owner.

sec(5) Any violations of sec. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, of this Ordinance shall be deemed Prima facia evidence of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding \$25, for first offence and less than \$25, for a second, nor more than \$50, for a second offence, and by a fine of not more than \$100, for a third offence and for any subsequent within one year with costs in each, and every case and be imprisoned in the County Jail until said fine and costs are paid, secured to be paid, or otherwise discharged according to Law.

sec(6) All fines collected for any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be for the general fund of said Village.
