Ordinance No. 13-

TO Regulate the speed of Moter Vehicle

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) That no person shall operate a moter vachicle on the streets or highways of a rate of speed greater than is reasonable or proper, secl4 having regard to the width and the use of the highway, or street vol and the general cause usual, kules of such street, or Road, so as 1908 not to endanger the property or limb of any person, of the safety Ohio of any property.

sec(2) In no event shall any Automobile Moter Vehicle Moter Cicle be operated at a greater rate of speed than eight miles an hour in the business or closely built up portions of said Village.

sec(3) The closely built up portion of the said Vilage of Centerville secl5 shall be as follows, on north main street beginning at the Public vol Watering Trough, thence south on said main street to, and including 1908 the Kindle lands, and Residance. An the East beginning with the Ohio residence of Mrs. Elliott, and extending West to and including Laws the residence of D. B. Stancel. Fage 541

sec(1) Any operator of a Moter Vicicle upon meeting a horsedrawn Wehiele, or overtaking one or person on horseback shall slow down. and stop said Moter Vehicle when signaled so to do, and shall re main in such condition until such borsedrawn Vebacle or other such other person on horseback shall have safely passed, provided however, sec16 that signal to stop be given in good faith, and under the necessity of the elreumstances, and only so often and for such length Vol 1908 of time as shall permit such Vehicle to safely pass, whether aproach Page ing from the front or from the rear, and in case of accident to a 541 person, or property on the public highway of said Village due to the operator thereon of a Moter Vehicle. The person operating such Vehicle Obio Laws shall stop, and upon request of a person injured, or any person present give such person his name, and adress, and if not the owner, the name, and and adress of such owner.

sec(5) Any violations of sec. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, of this Ordinance shall be deemed Prima facia evidence of a misdimeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding \$25, for first offence and less than \$25, for a second, 1903 nor more than \$50, for a second offence, and by a fine of not more than \$100, for a third offence and for any subsequent within one Lews year with costs in each, and every case and be imprisoned in the Page County Jail until said fine and costs are paid, secured to be paid, or 543 otherwise discharged according to Haw.

sec(6) All fines collected for any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be for the general fund of said Village.
