

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

(Revised)

Ordinance No. 18

TO Prevent Minors under the age of sixteen years from Loitering, Strolling or Meandering on Streets or other Public places.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) IT BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY MINOR UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN YEARS TO loiter, meander, or stroll about in the night time after the hour of eight oclock P. M. from the first day of April to the first day of November, and seven thirt^y oclock from the first day of November to the first day of April, on any of the streets, highways, alleys, lanes or commons, or any of the public places of said Village unless by the direction of or accompanied by their Parents, or Guardians or other person having the legal custody of such minor.

sec(2) The Marshal of said village shall ring the bell at the station house as a warning to all minors under the age of sixteen years at eight oclock P. M. from April first to November first, and from November first to April first at seven oclock.

sec(3) Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any sum not exceeding ten dollars and be confined in Village Prison until said fine and costs are paid, M C secured to be paid, or otherwise discharged according to Law.
