Ordinance No. 20TO Provide against resisting MarshallBE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to resist the Marshall of said Village in any way in the discharge of his official duties.

sec(2) Any person violating any of the provisions of Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not exceeding fifty dollars and costs of prosecution and be confined in the County Jail until said fine and costs are paid, or secured to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.
