

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 23

TO Against Contempt of Court

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village  
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to corruptly, by threats, force, or bribes to influence, or try to influence or intimidate or impede in any way, or manner any Juror, Wittness, or Officer, in the Mayors Court of the Village of Centerville, or shall be guilty of any disorderly contemptions, or insolent behaviour toward the Mayor of said Village tending to interupt the due course of trial or other judicial proceeding before said Mayor, or shall advise any person, or persons on trial, or any wittness to disobey the order of said mayor.

sec(2) Any person, or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any sum not exceeding Twenty dollars, and costs of prosecution and be confined in the County Jail until said fine, and costs are paid, secured to be paid  
M C or otherwise discharged according to Law.
