

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 24TO Regulate Motor VehiclesBE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ride or propel any bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle, or similar vehicle through or upon the streets of said village at a rate of speed exceeding eight miles an hour in rounding any of the corners of said streets, avenues, alleys, highway or public places at a rate of speed exceeding four miles an hour.

sec(2) It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons to ride, or propel any bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle, or similar vehicle through or upon the streets, avenues, alleys, highways, or public places within said village, during the night season without carrying or attaching to same, a lamp, or lantern properly lighted, and giving sufficient light to indicate the approach, or presence, bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle, or similar vehicle.

sec(3) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons riding or propelling any bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle, or similar vehicle upon any of the paved, or gravelled sidewalks or parks of said village.

sec(4) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons riding, or propelling any bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle, or similar vehicle through, or upon the streets, avenues, alleys, highways, or public places within said village, to turn to the left of any other person, or persons approaching said person or persons, and riding or propelling any bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle or similar vehicle.

sec(5) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ride, or propel any bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle, or other similar vehicle through or upon the streets, avenues, alleys, highways, or public places of said village while riding abreast of more than one other person, or persons riding, or propelling any such bicycle, tricycle, tanden bicycle, or similar vehicle.

sec(6) Any person or persons, violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offense, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not less than one dollar nor more than Ten dollars, for the general fund of said village to be appropriated and used by said Council for the use, and benefit of

M C said village, and shall also pay the costs of prosecution.
