Ordinance No. 25

TO Provide for Jury in Mayors Court

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) ^{sec}In all cases where a jury is demanded in the Mayors Court, the mayor shall write in a panel the names of ten individuals, citizens of said village. This panel shall not contain the name of any person who has heretofore been drawn or served as a juror within the last thirty days. From this panel the defendant, his agent, or attorney shall first strike one name, then the plaintiff his agent, or attorney shall strike one name, and so alternately until each party shall have stricken two names. The remaining six shall constitute the jury to try such case.

sec(2) If either party neglect, or refuse to aid in striking the jury mayor shall strike the same in behalf of such party. The mayor then proceeds with the case, in the same manner as is provided for M C justices of the Peace.
