Ordinance No. 26

(Revised)

TO BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT

AS PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CANTON, OHIO

Section 1. That all cases where a jury is demanded in the Mayor's Court, the
court shall write in a panel the names of ten individuals
eligible of said village. This panel shall not contain the name of
of any person who has previously been sworn or served as a juror
within the last thirty days. From this panel the defendant, the
agent, or attorney shall first strike one name, then the plaintiff
his agent, or attorney shall strike one name, and so alternately
until each party shall have stricken two names. The remaining six shall
constitute the jury to try such case.

Section 2. If either party neglect, or refuse to aid in striking the jury
panel shall strike the same in behalf of such party. The court
then proceeds with the case, in the same manner as is provided for
in the ordinances of the city.
