

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

(Revised) Ordinance No. 29

TO Provide and regulate Exhibitions or Shows

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to carry on any Theatrical Exhibition, or Public Show of any name or nature for which money is demanded or received, such as juggling slight of hand ventriloquism within the limits of said Village of Centerville without first obtaining from the Mayor a License for so doing the amount of said License to be not more than Five Dollars. But public lectures or historic, literary, or scientific subjects shall not come within the provisions of this Ordinance.

sec(2) Any person or persons violating this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not more than Ten dollars and costs of prosecution and be confined in the County Jail until said fine, and costs are paid, secured to be paid or otherwise discharged according to Law.
