

RECORD OF ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 30

TO Provide against Loafing in any Telephone Exchange, or any Public Places.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED Village
OF Centerville Montgomery County OHIO, THAT

sec(1) It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons to enter any Telephone Exchange within the limits of said Village, or any Public place, or any street, or alley, or any park within the limits of said Village and while there to use any immorallanguage, or to exhibit, or partake an offer to any one else, any spiritous, molt, or vinus liquor, or to conduct himself, or herself in any disorderly manner or any driver of any automobile, or any operator of any motor bicycle or any one in charge of any steam engine of any kind to permit the power to run while not in motion.

sec(2) Any person, or persons violating of the provision. of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any sum not exceeding Twenty five dollars, and costs of prosecution and be imprisoned until said fine and costs are paid, secured to be paid, or otherwise discharged according to Law.
