A COMMERCIAL CARD ACCOUNT AGREEMENT WITH U.S. BANK

**WHEREAS**, the City of Centerville currently has credit card services through U.S. Bank, NA, which agreement is expiring; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Centerville is desirous of obtaining credit card services to allow the City of Centerville to continue to use credit cards for purchases; and

**WHEREAS**, U.S. Bank National Association provides such services to allow; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the City of Centerville to use credit cards for some purchases pursuant to the City's credit card policy; and


**WHEREAS**, U.S. Bank National Association facilitates such services.

The City hereby agrees to enter into a Commercial Card Account Agreement with U.S. Bank National Association. and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement with U.S. Bank National Association in a form substantially similar to the contract attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein on behalf of the City of Centerville.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
