ORDINANCE NO. 15-20

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER JoAnne Rau ON THE 6<sup>th</sup> DAY OF July, 2020.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE CREATION OF THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND.

WHEREAS, Section 5705.12 of the Ohio Revised Code grants permission to the taxing authority of a subdivision to establish special funds; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in House Bill 481 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

WHEREAS, H.B. 481 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 801 formerly 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville adopted a resolution in accordance to such regulations; and

WHEREAS, a special fund is needed to properly account for such deposits from the County and related expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That there is established the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund, a special revenue fund.


Section 2. That all proceeds from the Montgomery County Local Coronavirus Relief Fund will be received into the Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

Section 3. That appropriate expenditures from this fund be for the be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section


5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 801 formerly 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance pursuant to the CARES Act.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact of the immediate necessity to facilitate the creation of a revenue account for the CARES Act. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption in accordance with Section 5.05 of the Charter of the City.
