

Held June 11, 19 79

The Council of the City of Centerville, County of Montgomery, State of Ohio, met in Special Session on Monday, June 11, 1979 at 8:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Centerville Municipal Building. Mr. Kenning explained the need to purchase a waste packer truck as an emergency. The 1975 Packer Truck burned completely and must be replaced immediately. The City can purchase a 1971 Mac Diesel Waste Packer, same size, for \$3,500.00. Mrs. Lake suggested that the next issue of the City Newsletter request that residents not place charcoal embers in waste for pick up. Mrs. Lake sponsored Resolution Number 18-79, A Resolution Declaring A Public Disaster And Authorizing The Purchase Of One Garbage Packer Truck, and moved that it be passed. Mr. Siler seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion.
