After review of the CCIC history and files, it was suggested by Municipal Attorney Mr. Liberman to energize the group to accomplish the goals of the strategic plan.

There was a motion by Brooks Compton, seconded by John Beals and passed with a 7-0 vote to revised the code of regulations for the CCIC as it has not been revised since 1973. Municipal Attorney, Mr. Scott Liberman will revise and amend the document.
