The purpose of this meeting being called was to discuss the utilization of the Centerville Community Improvement Corporation as an Agency for the development of the Centerville Golf Course Community. Under consideration was a proposal for the development of a residential pod by which the City of Centerville would take advance reservations for lots with a non-refundable 20% down payment required; this revenue would then be placed in the CCIC account and used as front money to put infrastructures in place. It was the conclusion of the trustees that this proposal be reviewed by Legal Counsel.
