MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CENTERVILLE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the call of the President and notice duly given to the Board of Trustees, a special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Centerville Community Improvement Corporation was held on the 6th day of April, 1931 at 100 West Spring Valley Road, Centerville, Ohio.

Mr. Siler seconded the motion and the vote in favor of the motion was unanimous.
