

ORDINANCE NO. 5-67

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary for the protection of the Public Health, Safety, and Welfare that this Ordinance take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the COUNCIL of the VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, that:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 1967, the annual salaries, and all future salary increases heretofore authorized, of members of the Police Department of the Village of Centerville, Ohio, are increased eight (8%) percent above previously authorized levels.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure because of the necessity of continuing to maintain the highest quality Police Department for the Village. This Ordinance shall therefore be effective immediately upon its passage. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
